



Hastings Reef Site Arrangements

Hastings Reef is an important area for tourism.

Follow the special requirements for this location to help protect the Great Barrier Reef Marine Park values.

Both Localities


- Vessels less than 35 metres can access and anchor
- Vessels greater than 35 metres and no more than 70 metres can anchor outside the Location or at a Reef Anchorage if available
- No anchoring within 50 metres of a mooring

Hastings Reef Locality 1

- Intensive use Location
- Two Reef anchorages available
- Two private moorings allowed above the number permitted on 22 June 1998

Hastings Reef Locality 2

- Moderate use Location
- No anchoring within 200 metres of pontoon
- Reef anchorage available
- One pontoon allowed
- 3 private moorings allowed
- * Group sizes are including crew and excluding children under 4
- * The boundary of a 'Location' is generally 500 metres from the seaward edge of the reef
- * A primary mooringthat also has northerly mooring are considered one mooring
