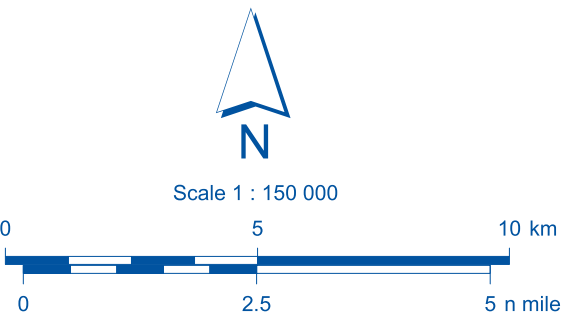
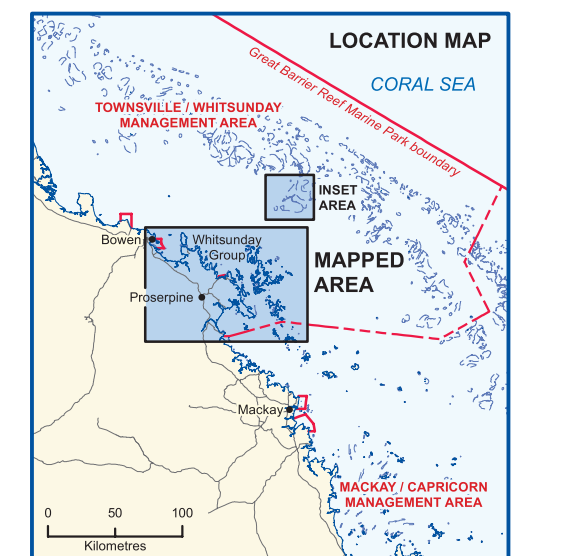


# Great Barrier Reef Marine Parks Zoning
