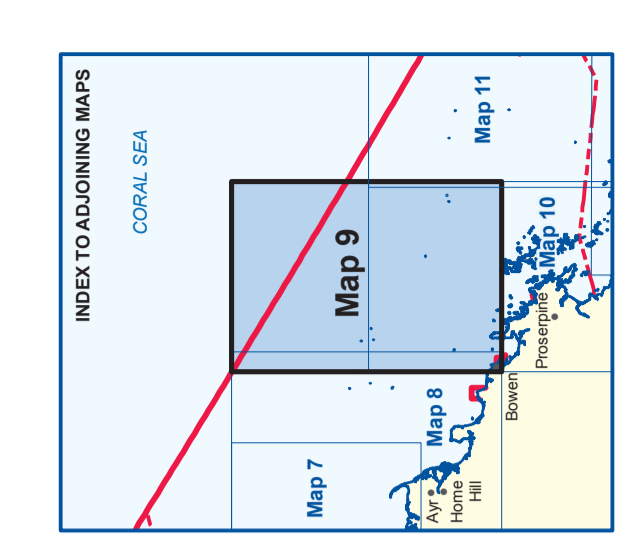

IMPORTANT NOTES FOR MAP USERS

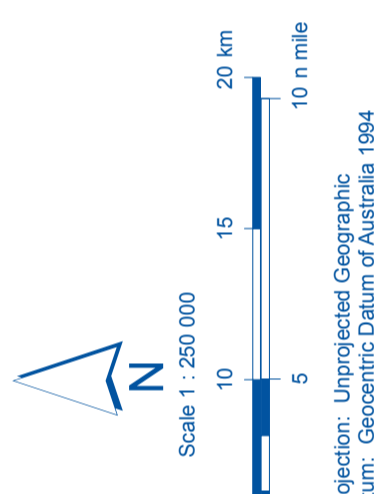
