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ZONING PLAN

PART ONE - PRELIMINARY

1 EFFECT OF ZONING PLAN

This Zoning Plan:

- (a) provides for the division of the Central Section of the Great Barrier Reef Marine Park into zones and assigns a name to each such zone; and
- (b) makes provision with respect to the purposes for which each such zone is to be, or may be, used or entered.

2 INTERPRETATION

2.1 In this Zoning Plan unless the contrary intention appears:

"Aboriginal" means a person who is a member of the Aboriginal race of Australia;

"Act" means the Great Barrier Reef Marine Park Act 1975;

"Aircraft Landing Area" means an area for the time being declared by the responsible agency in accordance with clause 3.6 to be an Aircraft Landing Area;

"amateur net"

means a net declared in the Regulations for the purposes of this definition;

"Central Section"

means the area declared to be part of the Great Barrier

Reef Marine Park by the Proclamation made under

sub-section 31(1) of the Act and published in the Gazette

on 15 October 1984 and assigned by that Proclamation the

name "Great Barrier Reef Marine Park - Central Section";

"collecting"

means the taking of any animal, plant or marine product declared in the Regulations for the purposes of this definition;

"commercial netting"

means netting using any net declared in the Regulations for the purposes of this definition;

"drop purse seine net" means a net declared in the Regulations for the purposes of this definition;

"fishing"

means the taking of fish, crustaceans, echinoderms or molluscs, but does not include the taking of any animal declared in the Regulations for the purposes of this definition;

"hook"

means a single hook or a group of hooks linked together;

"Islander"

means a person who is a member of the race to which
Torres Strait Islanders belong;

"line fishing"

means fishing with a device which incorporates a line with no more than six hooks;

"manipulative research"

means any research which by the nature of its activities will result in significant damage, degradation or disruption to the physical environment or living resources of the Marine Park;

"netting"

means the taking of fish by means of a net;

"power-head"

means a device by means of which a fish may be taken, being a device that may be attached to a spear and that consists of or contains an explosive charge;

"reef"

includes bommie fields, sandy flats, reef slopes, moats and ramparts;

"Reef
Appreciation
Area"

means an area for the time being declared by the responsible agency in accordance with clause 3.5(1) to be a Reef Appreciation Area;

"reef edge"

means the seaward edge of a reef;

"Reef Research
Area"

means an area for the time being declared by the responsible agency in accordance with clause 3.5(2) to be a Reef Research Area;

"Regulations"

means Regulations made under the Act;

"Replenishment
Area"

means an area for the time being declared by the responsible agency in accordance with clause 3.3(1) to be a Replenishment Area;

"Schedule"

means a Schedule to this Zoning Plan;

"ship"

means a vessel with a gross tonnage in excess of 500;

"Shipping Area"

means an area for the time being declared by the responsible agency in accordance with clause 3.7 to be a Shipping Area;

"take"

in relation to animals, plants and marine products includes remove, gather, catch, capture, kill, destroy, dredge for, raise, carry away, bring ashore or obtain by any means or endeavour to carry out any of those acts, but does not include picking up individual specimens of any animal, plant or marine product from a place for

recreational, educational or research purposes, provided that such specimens are subsequently replaced in the same general place without damage to the specimen or that place;

"the 5 kilometre

line"

line"

means the line every point of which is at a distance of 5 kilometres seaward from the nearest point of the coastline of the mainland at low water;

"the 500 metre

means the line every point of which is at a distance of 500 metres seaward from the nearest point of the reef edge of the reef to which it applies; and "the one kilometre line" and "the 100 metre line" have corresponding meanings;

"the coastal
500 metre line"

means the line every point of which is at a distance of 500 metres seaward from the nearest point of the coast-line at low water of the island or the mainland, as the case may be, to which it applies, or where there is a fringing reef wholly or partly around that island or wholly or partly along that mainland, 500 metres seaward from the nearest point of the reef edge of that fringing reef;

"the median line"

means the line every point of which is equidistant from the nearest points of the reef edges of the reefs to which it applies; "traditional fishing"

means fishing, otherwise than for purposes of sale or trade, in an area by a traditional inhabitant or a group of traditional inhabitants;

"traditional hunting and gathering"

means collecting, otherwise than for purposes of sale or trade, in an area by a traditional inhabitant or a group of traditional inhabitants;

"traditional inhabitant"

means an Aboriginal or Islander who lives in an area or areas in accordance with Aboriginal tradition or Islander tradition, respectively;

"vessel"

means a ship, boat, raft or pontoon or any other thing capable of carrying persons or goods through or on water, but does not include a hovercraft.

- 2.2 A reference in a provision of this Zoning Plan to the responsible agency is a reference to the person or body having, under the Regulations, a function or functions for the purposes of that provision.
- 2.3 A reference in this Zoning Plan to the Zoning Maps is a reference to the maps which form part of this Zoning Plan.
- 2.4 This Zoning Plan does not apply to an island, or a part of an island, that forms part of Queensland and is not owned by the Commonwealth.

2.5 A reference in a provision of this Zoning Plan to a vessel that is stranded, or is wrecked, sunk or abandoned does not apply to a wreck proclaimed under the Historic Shipwrecks Act 1976.

3 ZONES AND AREAS

3.1 Zones

- (1) For the purposes of the Act, the Central Section is divided into zones in accordance with this clause.
- (2) Subject to clauses 3.1(3) and (4), so much of the areas described in Column 2 of an item in Schedule One as are within the Central Section together constitute a zone having the name set out in Column 1 of the item.
- (3) Where a part of a boundary of a zone is described by reference to a line every point of which is a particular distance seaward from the nearest point of the reef edge of a reef and that line intersects the reef edge of another reef then the boundary of the zone shall be the median line between those reefs.
- (4) Where a part of a boundary of a zone is described by reference to a line every point of which is a particular distance seaward from the nearest point of the reef edge of a reef and that line intersects a part of a boundary of another zone (being a part of a boundary described by reference to a line every point of which is also that distance seaward from the nearest point of the reef edge of another reef) then the boundary of each of those zones between the outermost points at which those lines intersect shall be the median line between those reefs.

(5) To assist readers of this Zoning Plan, the approximate locations of reef edges are indicated on the Zoning Maps by the reef edge lines.

3.2 Notation of Zones on Zoning Maps

To assist readers of this Zoning Plan, the approximate locations of the zones described in clause 3.1 are indicated on the Zoning Maps in accordance with the following table:

3.3 Areas of Periodic Restricted Use

(1) Replenishment Areas

Within the General Use 'A' Zone and General Use 'B' Zone there may be Replenishment Areas. The objective of a Replenishment Area is to provide, for a specified period of time, an area which is closed to activities, other than trolling for pelagic species or permitted research,

which remove living resources of the Marine Park to enable the recovery of fish and other resource stocks.

The responsible agency may declare one or more of the areas comprised within the following groups of areas to be a Replenishment Area or to be Replenishment Areas, as the case may be, during such period as is, or such periods as are, specified by the responsible agency. Within each group of areas only one area may be declared to be a Replenishment Area at any one time.

Group A

The areas enclosed within the 500 metre line of each of the following reefs:

- (a) Pith Reef; and
- (b) Trunk Reef.

Group B

The area the boundary of which:

- (a) commences at the westernmost point of the 500 metre line around Bramble Reef;
- (b) runs thence south-easterly along that 500 metre line to its southernmost point;
- (c) thence south-westerly along the geodesic which passes through the northernmost point of the coastal 500 metre line around Curacoa Island to its intersection by the meridian of Longitude 146° 39' East;

- (d) thence north-westerly along the geodesic to the point of intersection of the geodesic between the westernmost point of the 500 metre line around Bramble Reef and the northernmost point of the coastal 500 metre line around Pelorus Island by the meridian of Longitude 146⁰ 34.2' East; and
- (e) thence north-easterly along the geodesic to the point of commencement.

Group C

The area the boundary of which:

- (a) commences at the northernmost point of the coastal 500 metre line around Pelorus Island;
- (b) runs thence north-easterly along the geodesic which passes through the westernmost point of the 500 metre line around Bramble Reef to its intersection by the meridian of Longitude 146⁰ 34.2' East;
- (c) thence south-easterly along the geodesic to the point of intersection of the geodesic between the southernmost point of the 500 metre line around Bramble Reef and the northernmost point of the coastal 500 metre line around Curacoa Island by the meridian of Longitude 146⁰ 39' East;
- (d) thence south-westerly along the geodesic which passes through the northernmost point of the coastal 500 metre line around Curacoa Island to its intersection by the geodesic between the easternmost point of the coastal 500 metre line around Pelorus Island and the northernmost

point of intersection of the meridian of Longitude $146^{\circ}41$ ' East and the coastal 500 metre line around Great Palm Island;

- (e) thence north-westerly along that geodesic to the easternmost point of the coastal 500 metre line around Pelorus Island; and
- (f) thence generally northerly and north-westerly along that coastal 500 metre line to the point of commencement.

Group D

The areas enclosed within the coastal 500 metre line of each of the following islands:

- (a) Herald Island; and
- (b) Acheron Island.

Group E

The areas enclosed with the 500 metre line of each of the following reefs:

- (a) Bowden Reef; and
- (b) Shrimp Reef.

Group F

The areas enclosed within the 500 metre line of each of the following reefs:

- (a) Lion Reef; and
- (b) Jaquar Reef.

Group G

The areas enclosed within the 500 metre line of each of the following reefs:

- (a) Line Reef; and
- (b) Black Reef East and the unnamed reef (reef 19-138) located at or about Latitude 19⁰49' South, Longitude 149⁰25' East.

Group H

The areas enclosed within the coastal 500 metre line of each of the following islands:

- (a) Langford and Bird Islands; and
- (b) Black Island.

3.4 Defence Areas

Within the Central Section there shall be Defence Areas. The objective of a Defence Area is to make provision, in the interests of public safety, for control of the use of, and entry into, an area used for the conduct of defence operations.

The Defence Areas are:

- (a) The area the boundary of which:
 - (i) commences at the point of intersection of the geodesic between the point of Latitude $17^{0}54$ ' South, Longitude $146^{0}18.5$ '

East and the point of Latitude $17^{0}47.5$ ' South, Longitude 146^{0} ll' East by the parallel of Latitude $17^{0}52.9$ ' South;

- (ii) runs thence south-easterly along the geodesic to the point of Latitude $17^{0}54$ ' South, Longitude $146^{0}18.5$ ' East;
- (iii) thence generally north-easterly along a line being the arc of a circle which passes through that point and with its centre at the point of Latitude $17^{0}40$ ' South, Longitude $146^{0}03.5$ ' East to its intersection by the parallel of Latitude $17^{0}52.9$ ' South; and
- (iv) thence westerly along that parallel of Latitude to the point of commencement.
- (b) The area the boundary of which:
 - (i) commences at the point of Latitude 18⁰48.75' South, Longitude 146⁰51.33' East;
 - (ii) runs thence south-westerly along the geodesic between that point and the point of Latitude 19^008 ' South, Longitude 146^047 ' East to its northernmost intersection by the coastline of Magnetic Island at low water;
- (iii) thence generally south-westerly, southerly and south-easterly along that coastline at low water to its westernmost intersection by the geodesic between the point of Latitude $19^{\circ}08^{\circ}$ South, Longitude $146^{\circ}47^{\circ}$ East and the point of Latitude $19^{\circ}09^{\circ}$ South, Longitude $146^{\circ}38.5^{\circ}$ East;

- (iv) thence south-westerly along that geodesic to its intersection by the coastal 5 kilometre line;
- thence generally north-westerly along that coastal 5 kilometre line to its intersection by the geodesic between the point of Latitude $19^001.5$ ' South, Longitude 146^028 ' East and the point of Latitude $18^055.66$ ' South, Longitude $146^023.66$ ' East;
- (vi) thence north-westerly along that geodesic to the point of Latitude 18⁰55.66' South, Longitude 146⁰23.66' East; and
- (vii) thence generally north-easterly along a line being the arc of a circle of 29 nautical miles radius and its centre at the point of Latitude $19^{0}17$ ' South, Longitude $146^{0}44.5$ ' East to the point of commencement.
- (c) The area the boundary of which:
 - (i) commences at the point of intersection of the meridian of Longitude 147⁰30' East by the geodesic between the point of Latitude 17⁰40.5' South, Longitude 147⁰16.95' East and the point of Latitude 19⁰39.66' South, Longitude 150⁰35' East;
 - (ii) runs thence south-easterly along that geodesic to its intersection by the meridian of Longitude 148⁰25' East;

- (iii) thence south along that meridian of Longitude to its intersection by the parallel of Latitude $19^{0}00$ ' South;
 - (iv) thence west along that parallel of Latitude to its intersection by the meridian of Longitude 147⁰30' East; and
 - (v) thence north along that meridian of Longitude to the point of commencement.

3.5 Closure of Limited Areas

(1) Reef Appreciation Areas

Within the General Use 'A' Zone, General Use 'B' Zone and Marine National Park 'A' Zone there may be Reef Appreciation Areas. The objective of a Reef Appreciation Area is to provide, on and around a heavily used reef, a small area in which the public may observe and appreciate relatively undisturbed marine life. Within such areas, fishing and collecting are not allowed.

The responsible agency may declare an area to be a Reef Appreciation Area during such period as is specified by the responsible agency. The Reef Appreciation Area or Areas for the time being declared in relation to a reef may not incorporate more than 20 percent of the area of that reef, nor more than 20 percent of the area enclosed within the 500 metre line around that reef.

The locations of Reef Appreciation Areas are not shown on the Zoning Map.

(2) Reef Research Areas

Within the General Use 'A' Zone, General Use 'B' Zone, Marine National Park 'A' Zone, and Marine National Park 'B' Zone there may be Reef Research Areas. The objective of a Reef Research Area is to provide, on and around a reef, a small area in which permitted research may be conducted undisturbed.

The responsible agency may declare an area to be a Reef Research Area during such period as is specified by the responsible agency. The Reef Research Area or Areas for the time being declared in relation to a reef may not incorporate more than 20 percent of the area of that reef, nor more than 20 percent of the area enclosed within the 500 metre line around that reef.

The locations of Reef Research Areas are not shown on the Zoning Map.

3.6 Aircraft Landing Areas

Within the General Use 'A' Zone, General Use 'B' Zone, Marine National Park 'A' Zone, and Marine National Park 'B' Zone there may be Aircraft Landing Areas. The objective of an Aircraft Landing Area is to make provision, in the interests of public safety and enjoyment of the reef environment, for an area where aircraft may land and take-off.

The responsible agency may declare an area to be an Aircraft Landing Area during such period as is specified by the responsible agency.

The locations of Aircraft Landing Areas are not shown on the Zoning Map.

3.7 Shipping Areas

Within the General Use 'B' Zone, Marine National Park 'A' Zone, and Marine National Park 'B' Zone there may be Shipping Areas. The objective of a Shipping Area is to make provision for the navigation and operation of ships.

The areas described in the Column in Schedule Two are Shipping Areas.

The responsible agency may declare any other area to be a Shipping Area.

Notation of Areas of Periodic Restricted Use, Defence Areas and Shipping Areas on the Zoning Map

To assist readers of this Zoning Plan, the approximate locations of the areas capable of being declared as Areas of Periodic Restricted Use, Defence Areas, and those Shipping Areas described in Schedule Two are indicated on the Zoning Map in accordance with the following table:

3.9 Navigation in Shipping Areas

CAUTION. Because shipping areas can be located outside shipping lanes these areas could contain reefs and other hazards to navigation.

4 APPLICATIONS FOR PERMISSION

(1) Where, in this Zoning Plan, provision is made for entry into, or use of, a zone with the permission of the responsible agency, the responsible agency:

- (a) shall, subject to clause 4(2), in considering an application for such permission, have regard to:
 - (i) the objectives of the zone;
 - (ii) the orderly and proper management of the zone;
 - (iii) the likely effect on future options for the zone;
 - (iv) the conservation of the natural resources of the Marine Park;
 - (v) the nature and scale of the proposed use in relation to the existing use and amenity, and the future or desirable use and amenity, of the area and of adjacent areas;
 - (vi) the size, extent and location of any proposed use in relation to any nearby use;
 - (vii) the likely effects of any proposed use on adjoining and adjacent areas and any possible effects of the proposed use on the environment and the adequacy of safeguards for the environment;
 - (viii) the proposed means of access to and egress from any use and the adequacy of provisions for aircraft or vessel mooring, landing, parking, loading and unloading;
 - (ix) the provisions for safeguarding human life and their adequacy;
 - (x) whether the proposed use or entry could have long-term cumulative effects; and
- (b) may grant such permission subject to such conditions as it thinks appropriate or may refuse to grant such permission.
- (2) The responsible agency, in considering an application for permission for entry into or use of a zone for the purpose of traditional

fishing or for the purpose of traditional hunting and gathering, shall in addition to the matters listed in clause 4(1)(a), have particular regard to:

- (a) the need for conservation of endangered species and in particular the capability of the subject population of that species to sustain harvesting;
- (b) the means to be employed in traditional fishing or traditional hunting and gathering, as the case may be;
- (c) the number of animals or plants or the amount of marine product to be taken;
- (d) the particular purpose for which the taking is proposed;
- (e) whether the entry and use of the area in which the activity is to take place will be in accordance with Aboriginal tradition or Islander tradition, as the case may be;
- (f) evidence that the applicant is a traditional inhabitant; and
- (g) the normal place of residence of the applicant.

5 GENERAL USE 'A' ZONE

5.1 Objectives of the Zone

The objectives of the General Use 'A' Zone are:

- (a) to provide opportunities for reasonable use consistent with the conservation of the Great Barrier Reef; and
- (b) to provide for Replenishment Areas where collecting and fishing other than trolling are prohibited for limited periods to enable resource stocks to regenerate.

5.2 Use and Entry

Subject to Part Four, the following are the only purposes for which the General Use 'A' Zone may be used or entered:

- (a) except in a Reef Research Area, recreational activities other than fishing or collecting;
- (b) except in a Replenishment Area, Reef Appreciation Area or Reef Research Area, fishing by means of:
 - (i) line fishing (including trolling);

- (ii) spearfishing subject to the following conditions:
 - not for purposes of sale or trade;
 - not with underwater breathing apparatus (other than a snorkel) and
 - not with a powerhead.
- (iii) commercial netting;
- (iv) netting, using an amateur net; or
 - (v) trawling;
- (c) except in a Replenishment Area, Reef Appreciation Area or Reef Research Area, collecting of shells, fish and invertebrates (except coral) other than for sale or trade;
- (d) in a Replenishment Area, trolling for pelagic species from the first day of May in a year to the thirty-first day of January in the following year;
- (e) except in a Reef Research Area, research other than manipulative research;
- (f) except in a Reef Research Area, the navigation and operation of vessels, provided that any equipment which is normally used for fishing or collecting is stowed or secured at all times at which the vessel is in a part of the Zone in which the use of that equipment is not permitted under this Zoning Plan;
- (g) the operation of aircraft:
 - (i) at an altitude of not less than 500 feet above ground or water; or

(ii) within an Aircraft Landing Area:

- on the surface of the ground or water, provided that any equipment which is normally used for fishing or collecting is stowed or secured at all times at which the aircraft is in a part of the Zone in which the use of that equipment is not permitted under this Zoning Plan; or
- at an altitude of less than 500 feet above ground or water when landing on or flying out from such an area;

(h) after notification to the responsible agency:

- (i) the conduct of defence operations in a Defence Area;
- (ii) the removal of a vessel that is wrecked, stranded, sunk or abandoned;
- (iii) the construction, conduct and servicing of authorised navigational aids and their ancillary buildings and works, including the operation of vessels and aircraft for these purposes;

(i) with the permission of the responsible agency:

- (i) except in a Replenishment Area, Reef Appreciation Area or Reef Research Area, collecting, otherwise than as specified in paragraph (c);
- (ii) manipulative research;
- - (iv) mariculture;
 - (v) the construction or provision of facilities for, or the establishment or conduct of, tourist or educational programs;
- (vi) the construction and conduct of mooring facilities for vessels;

- (vii) the operation of aircraft, otherwise than as specified in paragraphs (g) and (h):
 - on the surface of the ground or water; or
 - at an altitude of less than 500 feet above ground or water;
- (viii) the construction and conduct of landing areas for aircraft;
 - (ix) the use of hovercraft;
 - (x) harbour works, beach protection works or other works;
 - (xi) dumping of spoil;
 - (xii) the discharge of wastes from a fixed structure;
- (xiii) except in a Replenishment Area, Reef Appreciation Area or Reef Research Area, commercial pole and line tuna fishing, including catching bait by netting, using a drop purse seine net;
 - (xiv) except in a Replenishment Area, Reef Appreciation Area or Reef
 Research Area, traditional fishing (other than fishing
 specified in paragraph (b)) traditional hunting and gathering
 (other than collecting specified in paragraph (c));
 - (xv) in a Reef Research Area, the navigation and operation of vessels;
- (xvi) programs for the taking of an animal or animals which pose a threat to human life or safety;
- (xvii) any other purpose consistent with the objectives of the Zone.

6 GENERAL USE 'B' ZONE

6.1 Objectives of the Zone

The objectives of the General Use 'B' Zone are:

- (a) to provide opportunities for reasonable use consistent with the conservation of the Great Barrier Reef free from the effects of trawling;
- (b) to provide for Replenishment Areas where collecting and fishing other than trolling are prohibited for limited periods to enable resource stocks to regenerate;
- (c) to provide for Shipping Areas through which ships may pass.

6.2 Use and Entry

Subject to Part Four, the following are the only purposes for which the General Use 'B' Zone may be used or entered:

(a) except in a Reef Research Area, recreational activities other than fishing or collecting;

- (b) except in a Replenishment Area, Reef Appreciation Area or Reef Research Area, fishing by means of:
 - (i) line fishing (including trolling);
 - (ii) spearfishing subject to the following conditions:
 - not for purposes of sale or trade;
 - not with underwater breathing apparatus (other than a snorkel) and
 - not with a powerhead.
 - (iii) commercial netting; or
 - (iv) netting, using an amateur net;
- (c) except in a Replenishment Area, Reef Appreciation Area or Reef Research Area, collecting of shells, fish and invertebrates (except coral) other than for sale or trade;
- (d) in a Replenishment Area, trolling for pelagic species from the first day of May in a year to the thirty-first day of January in the following year;
- (e) except in a Reef Research Area, research other than manipulative research;
- (f) except in a Reef Research Area, the navigation and operation of vessels other than ships, provided that any equipment which is normally used for fishing or collecting is stowed or secured at all times at which the vessel is in a part of the Zone in which the use of that equipment is not permitted under this Zoning Plan;

(g) in a Shipping Area, the navigation and operation of ships, provided that any equipment which is normally used for fishing or collecting is stowed or secured at all times at which the vessel is in a part of the Zone in which the use of that equipment is not permitted under this Zoning Plan;

(h) the operation of aircraft:

- (i) at an altitude of not less than 500 feet above ground or water; or
- (ii) within an Aircraft Landing Area:
 - on the surface of the ground or water, provided that any equipment which is normally used for fishing or collecting is stowed or secured at all times at which the aircraft is in a part of the Zone in which the use of that equipment is not permitted under this Zoning Plan; or
 - at an altitude of less than 500 feet above ground or water when landing on or flying out from such an area;
- (i) after notification to the responsible agency:
 - (i) the conduct of defence operations in a Defence Area;
 - (ii) the removal of a vessel that is wrecked, stranded, sunk or abandoned;
 - (iii) the construction, conduct and servicing of authorised navigational aids and their ancillary buildings and works, including the operation of vessels and aircraft for these purposes;

- (j) with the permission of the responsible agency:
 - (i) except in a Replenishment Area, Reef Appreciation Area or Reef Research Area, collecting, otherwise than as specified in paragraph (c);
 - (ii) manipulative research;
 - - (iv) mariculture;
 - (v) the construction or provision of facilities for, or the establishment or conduct of, tourist or educational programs;
 - (vi) except in a Reef Research Area the navigation and operation of tourist cruise ships;
 - (vii) the construction and conduct of mooring facilities for vessels;
 - (viii) the operation of aircraft, otherwise than as specified in paragraphs (h) and (i):
 - on the surface of the ground or water; or
 - at an altitude of less than 500 feet above ground or water;
 - (ix) the construction and conduct of landing areas for aircraft;
 - (x) the use of hovercraft;
 - (xi) harbour works, beach protection works or other works;
 - (xii) the discharge of wastes from a fixed structure;
 - (xiii) except in a Replenishment Area, Reef Appreciation Area or Reef Research Area, commercial pole and line tuna fishing, including catching bait by netting, using a drop purse seine net;

- (xiv) except in a Replenishment Area, Reef Appreciation Area or Reef
 Research Area, traditional fishing (other than fishing
 specified in paragraph (b)) traditional hunting and gathering
 (other than collecting specified in paragraph (c));
 - (xv) in a Reef Research Area, the navigation and operation of vessels other than ships;
- (xvi) programs for the taking of an animal or animals which pose a threat to human life or safety;
- (xvii) any other purpose consistent with the objectives of the Zone.

7 MARINE NATIONAL PARK 'A' ZONE

7.1 Objectives of the Zone

The objectives of the Marine National Park 'A' Zone are:

- (a) to provide for the protection of the natural resources of the area while allowing the following uses:
 - (i) recreational activities;
 - (ii) limited fishing and permitted traditional fishing and traditional hunting and gathering; and
 - (iii) permitted research; and
- (b) to provide for Shipping Areas through which ships may pass.

7.2 Use and Entry

Subject to Part Four, the following are the only purposes for which the Marine National Park 'A' Zone may be used or entered:

- (a) except in a Reef Research Area, recreational activities other than fishing or collecting;
- (b) except in a Reef Appreciation Area or Reef Research Area, fishing by means of:

- (i) line fishing, other than trolling, by a person using equipment comprised of either one hand-held rod or one handline, and used with:
 - an artificial fly;
 - a lure; or
 - no more than one hook;
- (ii) trolling for pelagic species; or
- (iii) netting, using an amateur net;
- (c) except in a Reef Research Area, the navigation and operation of vessels other than ships, provided that any equipment which is normally used for fishing and collecting is stowed or secured at all times at which the vessel is in a part of the Zone in which the use of that equipment is not permitted under this Zoning Plan;
- (d) in a Shipping Area, the navigation and operation of ships, provided that any equipment which is normally used for fishing or collecting is stowed or secured at all times at which the vessel is in a part of the Zone in which the use of that equipment is not permitted under this Zoning Plan;
- (e) the operation of aircraft:
 - (i) at an altitude of not less than 500 feet above ground or water; or

(ii) within an Aircraft Landing Area:

- on the surface of the ground or water, provided that any equipment which is normally used for fishing or collecting is stowed or secured at all times at which the aircraft is in a part of the Zone in which the use of that equipment is not permitted under this Zoning Plan; or
- at an altitude of less than 500 feet above ground or water when landing on or flying out from such an area;
- (f) after notification to the responsible agency:
 - (i) the conduct of defence operations in a Defence Area;
 - (ii) the removal of a vessel that is wrecked, stranded, sunk or abandoned;
 - (iii) the construction, conduct and servicing of authorised navigational aids and their ancillary buildings and works, including the operation of vessels and aircraft for these purposes;
- (g) with the permission of the responsible agency:
 - (i) research (including collecting and manipulative research);
 - (ii) mariculture;
 - (iii) the construction or provision of facilities for, or the establishment or conduct of, tourist or educational programs;
 - (iv) except in a Reef Research Area, the navigation and operation of tourist cruise ships;
 - (v) the construction and conduct of mooring facilities for vessels;

- (vi) the operation of aircraft, otherwise than as specified in paragraphs (e) and (f):
 - on the surface of the ground or water; or
 - at an altitude of less than 500 feet above ground or water;
- (vii) the construction and conduct of landing areas for aircraft;
- (viii) the use of hovercraft;
 - (ix) harbour works, beach protection works or other works;
 - (x) the discharge of wastes from a fixed structure;
 - (xi) except in a Reef Appreciation Area or Reef Research Area, traditional fishing (other than fishing as specified in paragraph (b)) and traditional hunting and gathering;
 - (xii) in a Reef Research Area, the navigation and operation of vessels other than ships;
- (xiii) programs for the taking of an animal or animals which pose a threat to human life or safety;
 - (xiv) any other purpose consistent with the objectives of the Zone.

8 MARINE NATIONAL PARK 'B' ZONE

8.1 Objectives of the Zone

The objectives of the Marine National Park 'B' Zone are:

- (a) to provide for the protection of the natural resources of the area while allowing the public to appreciate and enjoy the relatively undisturbed nature of the area; and
- (b) to provide for Shipping Areas through which ships may pass.

8.2 Use and Entry

Subject to Part Four, the following are the only purposes for which the Marine National Park 'B' Zone may be used or entered:

- (a) except in a Reef Research Area, recreational activities other than fishing or collecting;
- (b) except in a Reef Research Area, the navigation and operation of vessels other than ships, provided that any equipment which is normally used for fishing or collecting is stowed or secured at all times;
- (c) in a Shipping Area, the navigation and operation of ships, provided that any equipment which is normally used for fishing or collecting is stowed or secured at all times;

- (d) the operation of aircraft:
 - (i) at an altitude of not less than 500 feet above ground or water; or
 - (ii) within an Aircraft Landing Area:
 - on the surface of the ground or water, provided that any equipment which is normally used for fishing or collecting is stowed or secured at all times; or
 - at an altitude of less than 500 feet above ground or water when landing on or flying out from such an area;
- (e) after notification to the responsible agency:
 - (i) the conduct of defence operations in a Defence Area;
 - (ii) the removal of a vessel that is wrecked, stranded, sunk or abandoned;
 - (iii) the construction, conduct and servicing of authorised navigational aids and their ancillary buildings and works, including the operation of vessels and aircraft for these purposes;
- (f) with the permission of the responsible agency:
 - (i) research (including collecting and manipulative research);
 - (ii) the construction or provision of facilities for, or the establishment or conduct of, tourist or educational programs;
 - (iii) except in a Reef Research Area, the navigation and operation of tourist cruise ships;
 - (iv) the construction and conduct of mooring facilities for vessels;

- (v) the operation of aircraft, otherwise than as specified in paragraphs (d) and (e):
 - on the surface of the ground or water; or
 - at an altitude of less than 500 feet above ground or water;
- (vi) the construction and conduct of landing areas for aircraft;
- (vii) the use of hovercraft;
- (viii) harbour works, beach protection works or other works;
 - (ix) the discharge of wastes from a fixed structure;
 - (x) except in a Reef Research Area, traditional fishing and traditional hunting and gathering;
 - (xi) in a Reef Research Area, the navigation and operation of vessels other than ships;
 - (xii) programs for the taking of an animal or animals which pose a threat to human life or safety;
- (xiii) any other purpose consistent with the objectives of the Zone.

9 PRESERVATION ZONE

9.1 Objective of the Zone

The objective of the Preservation Zone is to preserve areas of the Great Barrier Reef in their natural state undisturbed by man except for the purposes of scientific research.

9.2 Use and Entry

Subject to Part Four, the following are the only purposes for which the Preservation Zone may be used or entered:

- (a) the operation of aircraft at an altitude of not less than 500 feet above ground or water;
- (b) the navigation and operation of vessels for access to areas that form part of Queensland, provided that any equipment normally used for fishing or collecting is stowed or secured at all times;
- (c) after notification to the responsible agency:
 - (i) the removal of a vessel that is wrecked, stranded, sunk or abandoned;
 - (ii) the conduct and servicing of authorised navigational aids and their ancillary building and works, including the operation of vessels and aircraft for these purposes;

- (d) with the permission of the responsible agency:
 - (i) scientific research that cannot be carried out in any otherZone;
 - (ii) any other purpose consistent with the objective of the Zone.

PART FOUR - ADDITIONAL USES AND EXEMPTIONS

10 ACCESS IN SPECIAL CIRCUMSTANCES

In addition to the purposes for which a zone is to be, or may be, used or entered as specified in clauses 5, 6, 7, 8, and 9 of this Zoning Plan, a zone may be used or entered for the purpose of:

- (a) saving human life or avoiding the risk of injury to a human being;
- (b) locating or securing the safety of an aircraft, hovercraft or vessel which is, or may be, endangered by stress of weather or by navigational or operational hazards;
- (c) government geodetic surveys, reconnaissance, surveillance, or law enforcement (including enforcement of the Act and Regulations);
- (d) dealing with an emergency involving a serious threat to the environment.

11 STATUTORY NOTICES

Nothing in the Zoning Plan shall be construed as regulating, restricting, restraining or prohibiting the construction or display of signs or notices required by law.

12 PROTECTED SPECIES

Nothing in the Zoning Plan shall be construed as permitting the taking of any animal or plant protected under Commonwealth or Queensland legislation.

13 APPLICATION OF QUEENSLAND, COMMONWEALTH AND INTERNATIONAL LAW

- (1) Nothing in the Zoning Plan shall be construed as permitting any activity otherwise prohibited under the laws of the Commonwealth or Queensland.
- (2) Nothing in the Zoning Plan shall have any effect contrary to the obligations of the Commonwealth Government under international law.
