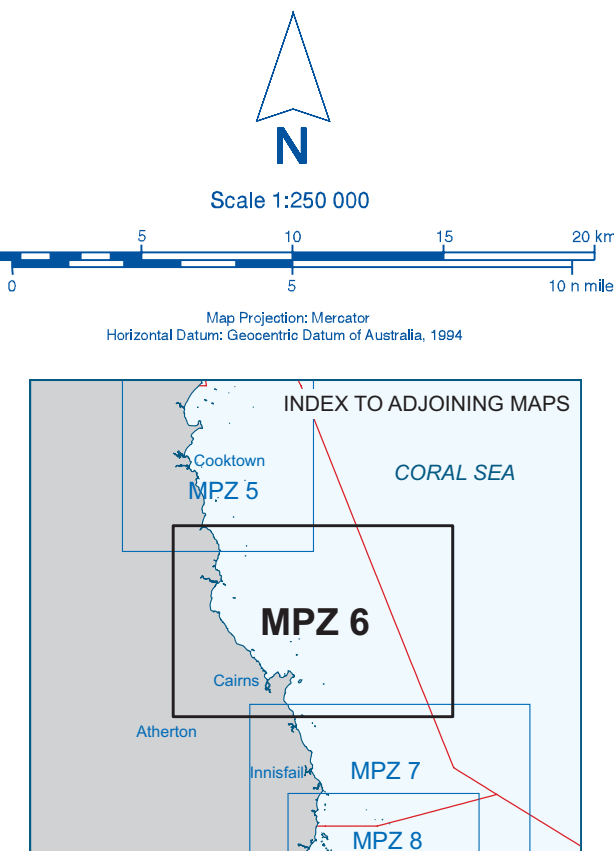

PLEASE NOTE: This guide provides an introduction to the Zoning in the Great Barrier Reef Marine Park. Relevant Queensland Marine Park Zoning Plans or the Queensland's Environmental Protection Agency should be consulted for comprehensive use or entry restrictions.

1. Restrictions apply to aquaculture, extracting and harvesting fish and marine life, beachcombing and other in the Conservation Zone.
2. Except for the One Island Reef (SP-23-2010) and Australian Islands (SP-19-2008) which are closed to public access and shown as orange on all other Great Barrier Reef Zoning Plans shown as green with all orange on orange.
3. Limited to 1000 people (excluding divers, divers' support and other persons) per day.
4. Hard or hand-held metal equipment and generally no more than 6 of a species.
5. Maximum of 3 minutes per person per day.
6. Limited to 1000 people per hour and 1 hour per site. Only 1 day offed from a commercial fishing vessel.
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Detailed information is contained in the Great Barrier Reef Marine Park Zoning Plan and Regulations.

- Permits are required for most other activities not listed above.
- Commonwealth owned islands in the Great Barrier Reef Marine Park are zoned "Commonwealth Islands Zones" - shown as cream.
- All Commonwealth islands in the Great Barrier Reef Marine Park are zoned "Commonwealth Islands Zones" - shown as cream.
- Special Management Areas may provide for additional restrictions at some locations.
- The Zoning Plans show the effect of operation of a 211 of the Native Title Act 1993.

IMPORTANT NOTES FOR MAP USERS

This map may not show all Queensland State Marine Park zoning (for example, State Marine Parks) where declared between high and low water. For more information on these areas, please refer to the relevant Queensland Government website. Consult the Queensland Environmental Protection Agency offices. Restrictions and/or closures under Queensland legislation (e.g. Fisheries Regulation 1995 (Qld)) are not shown. Users should liaise with themselves with local requirements relevant to their particular activities before entering or using the Great Barrier Reef Marine Park.

The inshore boundary of the Great Barrier Reef Marine Park follows the coastline of Queensland's coastline, except to the extent such waters are within the limits of the State Government's coastal management section 14 of the Seas & Submerged Lands Act 1973, or where otherwise indicated. The Great Barrier Reef Marine Park Act 1975 (Qld) section 14 map is indicative only. Any depiction of the inshore boundary on this map is indicative only.
