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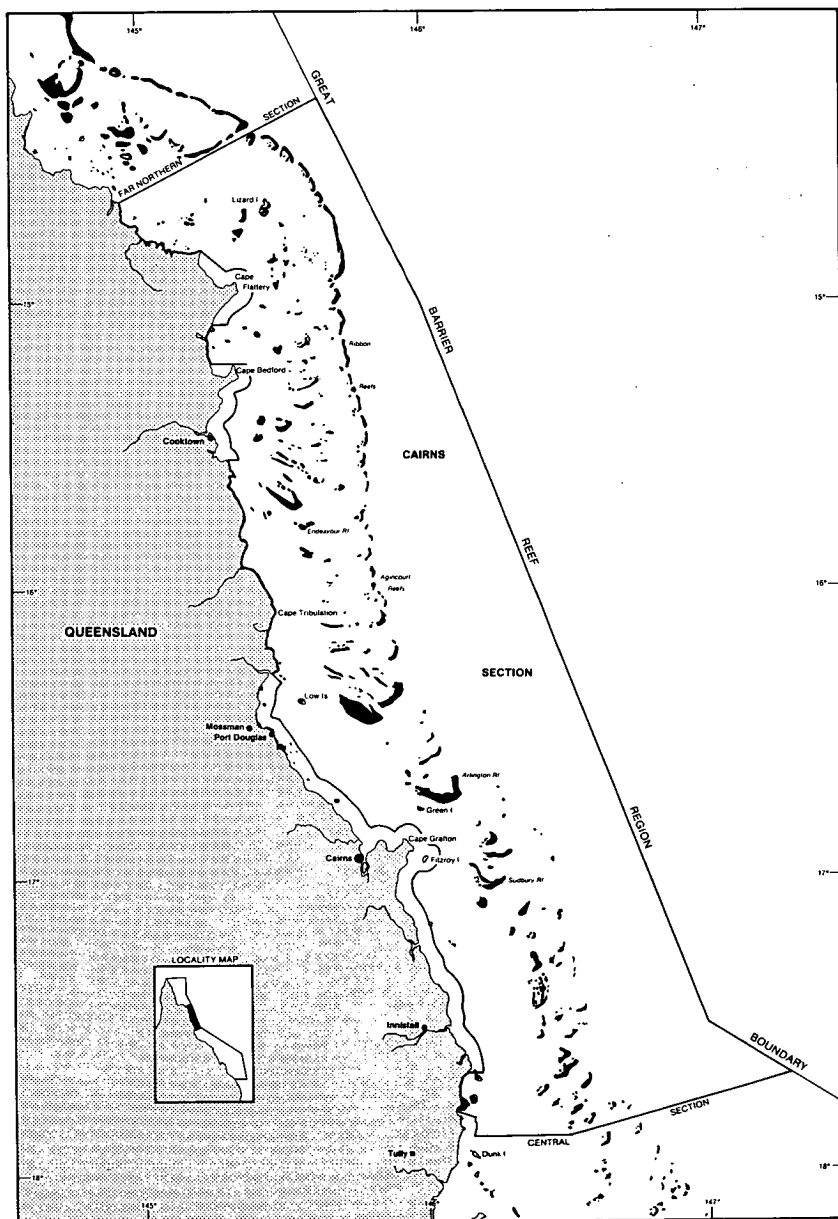
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PART ONE - PRELIMINARY

1 INTRODUCTION

The Great Barrier Reef Marine Park Act 1975 provides for the establishment, control, care and development of the Great Barrier Reef Marine Park. The Cairns Section was first proclaimed in 1981 (Commonwealth of Australia Gazette, 19 November 1981). It was amended by proclamation in 1989 (Commonwealth of Australia Gazette, 13 September 1989) with the amalgamation of the Cormorant Pass Section, which had previously been proclaimed in 1981. The map below shows the location and extent of the Cairns Section.



Great Barrier Reef Marine Park - Cairns Section

The framework for planning and management of the Cairns Section is provided by the Zoning Plan. The Zoning Plan regulates the purposes for which the Cairns Section may be used or entered in accordance with the following objects defined in the Act:

- (a) the conservation of the Great Barrier Reef;
- (b) the regulation of use of the Marine Park so as to protect the Great Barrier Reef while allowing the reasonable use of the Great Barrier Reef Region;
- (c) the regulation of activities that exploit the resources of the Great Barrier Reef Region so as to minimise the effect of those activities on the Great Barrier Reef;
- (d) the reservation of some areas of the Great Barrier Reef for its appreciation and enjoyment by the public; and
- (e) the preservation of some areas of the Great Barrier Reef in its natural state undisturbed by man except for the purposes of scientific research.

The Act also specifies that no operations for the recovery of minerals may be carried out within the Marine Park; except where such operations are carried out with the permission of the Authority for the purposes of research and investigations relevant to the establishment, care and development of the Marine Park, or for scientific research.

2 ABOUT THE ZONING PLAN

This Zoning Plan has been prepared in accordance with the Act to provide for the division of the Cairns Section into zones and to make provision with respect to the purposes for which each zone may be used or entered. The Zoning Plan also provides for 'No Structures Subzones' to provide some areas for appreciation and enjoyment by the public, free from infrastructure and facilities, and the designation of areas, within zones, where specific management conditions may be applied. For example, to regulate activities in heavily used areas to provide for public safety or to enable resource stocks to recover. Other activities which may require specific provisions are: shipping, defence training exercises and scientific research.

The Zoning Plan assigns one of the following names to each zone, subzone or designated area:

Name of Zone

- . General Use Zone
- . General Use (No Trawling) Zone
- . Marine Park Recreation Zone
- . Marine National Park Zone
- . Preservation Zone

Name of Subzone

- . No Structures Subzone

Name of Designated Area

- . Replenishment Area
- . Seasonal Closure Area
- . Defence Area
- . Shipping Area
- . Special Management Area

The boundaries of each zone and subzone, and the name assigned to each zone, are set out in the Schedule to this Zoning Plan. Where for the purposes of this Zoning Plan it is necessary to determine the position of a point, line or area, that determination shall be made by reference to the Australian Geodetic Datum 1966 (AGD 66).

The boundaries of nominated Seasonal Closure Areas, Replenishment Areas and Defence Areas are also set out in the Schedule. However, it should be noted that the designation of additional areas is provided for in this Zoning Plan.

The approximate locations of zones, subzones and designated areas are indicated on the copy of the Zoning Map inserted in this document.

3 APPLICATION OF QUEENSLAND, COMMONWEALTH AND INTERNATIONAL LAW

This Zoning Plan does not apply to an island, or a part of an island, that forms part of the State of Queensland and is not owned by the Commonwealth.

Nothing in the Zoning Plan shall:

- (a) be construed as permitting any activity otherwise prohibited under the laws of the Commonwealth or Queensland;
- (b) have any effect contrary to the obligations of the Commonwealth Government under international law;
- (c) be construed as permitting the taking of any animal or plant protected under Commonwealth or Queensland legislation;
- (d) be construed as regulating, restricting, restraining or prohibiting the construction or display of signs or notices required by law.

4 INTERPRETATION

For the purposes of this Zoning Plan, unless the contrary intention appears, the following definitions apply:

- Aboriginal means a person who is a member of the Aboriginal race of Australia;
- Act means the Great Barrier Reef Marine Park Act 1975;
- aircraft means a machine or apparatus that can derive support in the atmosphere from the reactions of the air or from buoyancy, but does not include a hovercraft;
- animal means any member, alive or dead, of the animal Kingdom (other than man) and includes:
(a) eggs or parts of eggs;
(b) the skin, feathers, shell or any other part of an animal;
- approved landing area or aerodrome means a landing area or aerodrome authorised for operation in accordance with the Air Navigation Act 1920;
- approved Reef Use Plan means a plan approved by the Authority which specifies in more detail how a defined area will be used and entered in accordance with the relevant zoning provisions;
- Authority means the Great Barrier Reef Marine Park Authority established by the Act;
- bait gathering means taking of yabbies, eugaries (pippies), bait worms or crabs when taken by hand or by hand-held implement;

<u>bait netting</u>	means <u>fishing</u> using a recreational bait net or a commercial bait net declared in the <u>Regulations</u> for the purposes of this definition;
<u>bait worms</u>	means worms belonging to the Class Polychaeta and which are taken for use as bait;
<u>Cairns Section</u>	means the area declared to be part of the Great Barrier Reef Marine Park by the Proclamation made under sub-section 31(1) of the Act and published in the Commonwealth of Australia Gazette on 13 September 1989 and assigned by that Proclamation the name "Great Barrier Reef Marine Park - Cairns Section";
<u>collecting</u>	means the <u>taking</u> of any animal, plant or marine product declared in the <u>Regulations</u> for the purposes of this definition;
<u>commercial netting</u>	means <u>fishing</u> using any net declared in the <u>Regulations</u> for the purposes of this definition;
<u>crabbing</u>	means the <u>taking</u> of crabs using any apparatus, including crab pots and dillies declared in the <u>Regulations</u> for the purposes of this definition;
<u>crabs</u>	means crustacea of the Section Brachyura;
<u>designated area</u>	means an area within a zone or zones set aside for the purposes of replenishment, seasonal closure, shipping, defence or special management;
<u>developmental fishery program</u>	means a program of <u>fishing</u> or <u>collecting</u> characterised by one or more of the following: (i) using equipment or techniques which have not previously been used in a commercial fishery in the Region; (ii) targetting, either wholly or in part, on a species for which there is not a commercial fishery in the Region; or (iii) being a program which the <u>Authority</u> has, by <u>written advertisement</u> , declared to be a developmental fishery program;
<u>drop purse seine netting</u>	means fishing using a drop purse seine net declared in the <u>Regulations</u> for the purposes of this definition;
<u>eugarie</u>	means a mollusc belonging to the species <u>Plebidonax deltoides</u> ;
<u>fishing</u>	means the <u>taking</u> of fish, crustaceans or molluscs declared in the <u>Regulations</u> for the purposes of this definition;
<u>hook</u>	means a single hook or a group of hooks linked (ganged) together;
<u>Islander</u>	means a person who is a member of the race to which Torres Strait Islanders belong;

<u>limited collecting</u>	means <u>collecting</u> of shells, fish and invertebrates (other than coral - Class Anthozoa) in accordance with the limitations declared in the <u>Regulations</u> for the purposes of this definition;
<u>limited crabbing</u>	means <u>crabbing</u> using no more than the prescribed number of crab pots, dillies, inverted dillies or other apparatus declared in the <u>Regulations</u> for the purposes of this definition;
<u>limited oyster gathering</u>	means the gathering of oysters (<u>oyster gathering</u>) for their immediate consumption;
<u>manipulative research</u>	means any research which by the nature of its activities will result in significant damage, degradation or disruption to the physical environment or living resources of the Marine Park and includes <u>taking</u> of specimens by <u>fishing</u> or <u>collecting</u> ;
<u>oyster gathering</u>	means the taking of shell-fish of the Family Ostreidae other than by dredging;
<u>photography and filming</u>	means the use of still, video or cine camera equipment for the recording of images or sound;
<u>plant</u>	means any member, alive or dead, of the plant Kingdom or of the fungus Kingdom and includes seeds and parts of plants;
<u>power-head</u>	means a device by means of which fish may be taken, being a device that may be attached to a spear and that consists of or contains an explosive charge;
<u>reef</u>	includes bommie fields, reef slopes, moats and ramparts;
<u>reef edge</u>	means the seaward edge of a <u>reef</u> ;
<u>Regulations</u>	means Regulations made under the <u>Act</u> ;
<u>Schedule</u>	means the Schedule to this Zoning Plan;
<u>ship</u>	means a vessel with a gross tonnage in excess of 1500;
<u>stowed or secured</u>	means equipment rendered inoperative and, in relation to trawl equipment, rendered inoperative at least to the extent of having nets out of water and hung on board with cod ends open;
<u>taking</u>	in relation to <u>animals</u> , <u>plants</u> and marine products includes <u>remove</u> , <u>gather</u> , <u>catch</u> , <u>capture</u> , <u>kill</u> , <u>destroy</u> , <u>dredge for</u> , <u>raise</u> , <u>carry away</u> , <u>bring ashore</u> or <u>obtain by any means</u> , or to endeavour to carry out any of those acts;

- the 5 kilo-
metre line means the line every point of which is at a distance of 5 kilometres seaward from the nearest point of the coastline of the mainland at low water;
- the 500 metre
line means the line every point of which is at a distance of 500 metres seaward from the nearest point of the reef edge of the reef to which it applies. "The one kilometre line" and "the 100 metre line" have corresponding meanings;
- the coastal
500 metre line means the line every point of which is at a distance of 500 metres seaward from the nearest point of the coastline at low water of the island or the mainland, as the case may be, to which it applies, or where there is a fringing reef wholly or partly around that island or wholly or partly along that mainland, 500 metres seaward from the nearest point of the reef edge of that fringing reef. "The coastal 100 metre line" has a corresponding meaning;
- the median
line means the line every point of which is equidistant from the nearest points of the reefs or coastline to which it applies;
- traditional
fishing means fishing, otherwise than for purposes of recreation, sale or trade, in an area by a traditional inhabitant or a group of traditional inhabitants;
- traditional
hunting and
gathering means collecting, otherwise than for purposes of recreation, sale or trade, in an area by a traditional inhabitant or a group of traditional inhabitants;
- traditional
inhabitant means an Aboriginal or Islander who lives in an area or areas in accordance with Aboriginal tradition or Islander tradition, respectively;
- vessel means a ship, boat, raft or pontoon or any other thing capable of carrying persons or goods through or on water, and includes a hovercraft;
- written
advertisement means a notice published in:
(a) the Commonwealth of Australia Gazette;
(b) a newspaper circulating generally in the State of Queensland; and
(c) a newspaper, if any, that is a local newspaper circulating in that part of the State of Queensland that is adjacent to the area to which the notice refers;
- yabbies means crustacea of the Genera Upogebia and Callianassa belonging to the Family Callianassidae.

PART TWO - ZONING PROVISIONS

5 GENERAL USE ZONE

5.1 Objective

To provide opportunities for reasonable general-use consistent with the conservation of the Great Barrier Reef Marine Park.

5.2 Use and Entry

Subject to Part Three (Designated Area Provisions) and Part Four (Additional Uses and Exemptions) and any conditions imposed by an approved Reef Use Plan, this clause sets out the only purposes for which the General Use Zone may be used or entered:

(a) unless otherwise stated in paragraph (b):

- (i) trolling;
- (ii) line fishing using no more than six hooks per line;
- (iii) spearfishing subject to the following conditions:
 - not for sale or trade;
 - not with underwater breathing apparatus (other than a snorkel);
 - not with a power-head;
- (iv) limited collecting;
- (v) oyster gathering;
- (vi) crabbing;
- (vii) bait gathering;
- (viii) bait netting;
- (ix) commercial netting;
- (x) trawling;
- (xi) recreational activities that do not involve the taking of plants, animals, or marine products;
- (xii) photography and filming;
- (xiii) non-manipulative research;
- (xiv) navigation and operation of vessels, other than hovercraft, provided that any equipment which is normally used for fishing or collecting is stowed or secured at all times at which the vessel is in a part of the Zone in which the use of that equipment is not permitted under this Zoning Plan;
- (xv) the operation of aircraft:
 - at an altitude of not less than 500 feet above ground or water; or
 - at an altitude of less than 500 feet when landing at or taking off from an approved landing area or aerodrome;

(b) with the written permission of the Authority or its delegate:

- (i) manipulative research;
- (ii) collecting (other than limited collecting specified in paragraph (a));
- (iii) line fishing using more than six hooks per line;
- (iv) commercial pole and line tuna fishing, including catching bait by drop purse seine netting;
- (v) the conduct of a developmental fishery program;
- (vi) traditional fishing and traditional hunting and gathering (other than fishing or collecting specified in paragraph (a));
- (vii) the farming of marine resources including the operation, construction, maintenance, demolition or removal of any associated facility;
- (viii) the operation of a tourist or education program including the construction, operation, maintenance, demolition or removal of any associated facility;
- (ix) the construction or conduct of mooring facilities for vessels;
- (x) the operation of a vessel with provision for more than 8 sleeping berths in the one vicinity for more than 14 consecutive days or for more than 30 days in any period of 60 days, including the conduct of operations in or upon, or the maintenance of, that vessel;
- (xi) the operation of a structure including the conduct of operations in or upon, the discharge of wastes from, or the building, assembling, fixing in position, maintenance or demolition of, that structure;
- (xii) the operation of aircraft other than as specified in paragraph (a);
- (xiii) the operation of a landing area, or facility for aircraft including the construction, maintenance, demolition or removal, of that landing area or facility;
- (xiv) the navigation and operation of a hovercraft;
- (xv) the dumping of spoil or the carrying out of reclamation works, beach protection works, harbour works, road building works or any other works;
- (xvi) camping;
- (xvii) programs for the taking of animals or plants which pose a threat to human life or safety, marine or island ecosystems which are part of the Marine Park or the use and amenity of an area or of adjacent areas;
- (xviii) any purpose not listed in this clause, consistent with the objective of the Zone.

6 GENERAL USE (NO TRAWLING) ZONE

6.1 Objective

To provide for the conservation of the Great Barrier Reef Marine Park while providing opportunities for reasonable general-use in areas that are free from trawling and generally free from shipping.

6.2 Use and Entry

Subject to Part Three (Designated Area Provisions) and Part Four (Additional Uses and Exemptions) and any conditions imposed by an approved Reef Use Plan, this clause sets out the only purposes for which the General Use (No Trawling) Zone may be used or entered:

(a) unless otherwise stated in paragraph (b):

- (i) trolling;
- (ii) line fishing using no more than six hooks per line;
- (iii) spearfishing subject to the following conditions:
 - not for sale or trade;
 - not with underwater breathing apparatus (other than a snorkel);
 - not with a power-head;
- (iv) limited collecting;
- (v) oyster gathering;
- (vi) crabbing;
- (vii) bait gathering;
- (viii) bait netting;
- (ix) commercial netting;
- (x) recreational activities that do not involve the taking of plants, animals, or marine products;
- (xi) photography and filming;
- (xii) non-manipulative research;
- (xiii) navigation and operation of vessels, other than hovercraft and other than ships, provided that any equipment which is normally used for fishing or collecting is stowed or secured at all times at which the vessel is in a part of the Zone in which the use of that equipment is not permitted under this Zoning Plan;
- (xiv) the operation of aircraft:
 - at an altitude of not less than 500 feet above ground or water; or
 - at an altitude of less than 500 feet when landing at or taking off from an approved landing area or aerodrome;

(b) with the written permission of the Authority or its delegate:

- (i) manipulative research;
- (ii) collecting (other than limited collecting specified in paragraph (a));

- (iii) line fishing using more than six hooks per line;
- (iv) commercial pole and line tuna fishing, including catching bait by drop purse seine netting;
- (v) the conduct of a developmental fishery program;
- (vi) traditional fishing and traditional hunting and gathering (other than fishing or collecting specified in paragraph (a));
- (vii) the farming of marine resources including the operation, construction, maintenance, demolition or removal of any associated facility;
- (viii) the operation of a tourist or education program including the construction, operation, maintenance, demolition or removal of any associated facility;
- (ix) the construction or conduct of mooring facilities for vessels;
- (x) the navigation and operation of ships for the purposes of tourism or research;
- (xi) the operation of a vessel with provision for more than 8 sleeping berths in the one vicinity for more than 14 consecutive days or for more than 30 days in any period of 60 days, including the conduct of operations in or upon, or the maintenance of, that vessel;
- (xii) the operation of a structure including the conduct of operations in or upon, the discharge of wastes from, or the building, assembling, fixing in position, maintenance or demolition of, that structure;
- (xiii) the operation of aircraft other than as specified in paragraph (a);
- (xiv) the operation of a landing area or facility for aircraft including the construction, maintenance, demolition or removal, of that landing area or facility;
- (xv) the navigation and operation of a hovercraft;
- (xvi) the dumping of spoil or the carrying out of reclamation works, beach protection works, harbour works, road building works or any other works;
- (xvii) camping;
- (xviii) programs for the taking of animals or plants which pose a threat to human life or safety, marine or island ecosystems which are part of the Marine Park or the use and amenity of an area or of adjacent areas;
- (xix) any purpose not listed in this clause, consistent with the objective of the Zone.

7 MARINE PARK RECREATION ZONE

7.1 Objective

To provide for the protection of areas of the Great Barrier Reef Marine Park while allowing opportunities for their appreciation and enjoyment by the public, including the limited removal of natural resources.

7.2 Use and Entry

Subject to Part Three (Designated Area Provisions) and Part Four (Additional Uses and Exemptions) and any conditions imposed by an approved Reef Use Plan, this clause sets out the only purposes for which the Marine Park Recreation Zone may be used or entered:

(a) unless otherwise stated in paragraph (b):

- (i) trolling for pelagic species;
- (ii) limited line fishing by a person using equipment comprised of either one hand-held rod or one handline, and used with:
 - no more than one hook; or
 - an artificial fly; or
 - a lure;
- (iii) limited oyster gathering;
- (iv) limited crabbing;
- (v) bait gathering;
- (vi) bait netting;
- (vii) recreational activities that do not involve the taking of plants, animals, or marine products;
- (viii) photography and filming;
- (ix) non-manipulative research;
- (x) navigation and operation of vessels, other than hovercraft and other than ships, provided that any equipment which is normally used for fishing or collecting is stowed or secured at all times at which the vessel is in a part of the Zone in which the use of that equipment is not permitted under this Zoning Plan;
- (xi) the operation of aircraft:
 - at an altitude of not less than 500 feet above ground or water; or
 - at an altitude of less than 500 feet when landing at or taking off from an approved landing area or aerodrome;

(b) with the written permission of the Authority or its delegate:

- (i) manipulative research;
- (ii) traditional fishing and traditional hunting and gathering (other than fishing or collecting specified in paragraph (a));
- (iii) the operation of a tourist or education program including the construction, operation, maintenance, demolition or removal of any associated facility;

- (iv) the construction or conduct of mooring facilities for vessels;
- (v) the navigation and operation of ships for the purposes of tourism or research;
- (vi) the operation of a vessel with provision for more than 8 sleeping berths in the one vicinity for more than 14 consecutive days or for more than 30 days in any period of 60 days, including the conduct of operations in or upon, or the maintenance of, that vessel;
- (vii) the operation of a structure including the conduct of operations in or upon, the discharge of wastes from, or the building, assembling, fixing in position, maintenance or demolition of, that structure;
- (viii) the operation of aircraft other than as specified in paragraph (a);
- (ix) the operation of a landing area or facility for aircraft including the construction, maintenance, demolition or removal, of that landing area or facility;
- (x) the navigation and operation of a hovercraft;
- (xi) the carrying out of works consistent with the objective of the Zone;
- (xii) camping;
- (xiii) programs for the taking of animals or plants which pose a threat to human life or safety, marine or island ecosystems which are part of the Marine Park or the use and amenity of an area or of adjacent areas;
- (xiv) any purpose not listed in this clause, consistent with the objective of the Zone.

8 MARINE NATIONAL PARK ZONE

8.1 Objective

To provide for the protection of areas of the Great Barrier Reef Marine Park while allowing opportunities for their appreciation and enjoyment by the public, free from activities that remove natural resources.

8.2 Use and Entry

Subject to Part Three (Designated Area Provisions) and Part Four (Additional Uses and Exemptions) and any conditions imposed by an approved Reef Use Plan, this clause sets out the only purposes for which the Marine National Park Zone may be used or entered:

- (a) unless otherwise stated in paragraph (b):
 - (i) recreational activities that do not involve the taking of plants, animals, or marine products;
 - (ii) photography and filming;
 - (iii) non-manipulative research;

- (iv) navigation and operation of vessels, other than hovercraft and other than ships, provided that any equipment which is normally used for fishing or collecting is stowed or secured at all times at which the vessel is in a part of the Zone in which the use of that equipment is not permitted under this Zoning Plan;
 - (v) the operation of aircraft:
 - at an altitude of not less than 500 feet above ground or water; or
 - at an altitude of less than 500 feet when landing at or taking off from an approved landing area or aerodrome;
- (b) with the written permission of the Authority or its delegate:
- (i) manipulative research;
 - (ii) traditional fishing and traditional hunting and gathering (other than fishing or collecting specified in paragraph (a));
 - (iii) the operation of a tourist or education program including the construction, operation, maintenance, demolition or removal of any associated facility;
 - (iv) the construction or conduct of mooring facilities for vessels;
 - (v) the navigation and operation of ships for the purposes of tourism or research;
 - (vi) the operation of a vessel with provision for more than 8 sleeping berths in the one vicinity for more than 14 consecutive days or for more than 30 days in any period of 60 days, including the conduct of operations in or upon, or the maintenance of, that vessel;
 - (vii) the operation of a structure including the conduct of operations in or upon, the discharge of wastes from, or the building, assembling, fixing in position, maintenance or demolition of, that structure;
 - (viii) the operation of aircraft other than as specified in paragraph (a);
 - (ix) the operation of a landing area or facility for aircraft including the construction, maintenance, demolition or removal, of that landing area or facility;
 - (x) the navigation and operation of a hovercraft;
 - (xi) the carrying out of works consistent with the objective of the Zone;
 - (xii) camping;
 - (xiii) programs for the taking of animals or plants which pose a threat to human life or safety, marine or island ecosystems which are part of the Marine Park or the use and amenity of an area or of adjacent areas;
 - (xiv) any purpose not listed in this clause, consistent with the objective of the Zone.

9 PRESERVATION ZONE

9.1 Objective

To provide for the preservation of areas of the Great Barrier Reef Marine Park in their natural state undisturbed by human activities.

9.2 Use and Entry

Subject to Part Three (Designated Area Provisions) and Part Four (Additional Uses and Exemptions) and any conditions imposed by an approved Reef Use Plan, this clause sets out the only purposes for which the Preservation Zone may be used or entered:

- (a) the operation of aircraft at an altitude of not less than 500 feet above ground or water;
- (b) with the written permission of the Authority or its delegate:
 - (i) scientific research that cannot be carried out in any other Zone;
 - (ii) any purpose not listed in this clause, consistent with the objective of the Zone.

10 NO STRUCTURES SUBZONE

10.1 Objective

To set aside, for the purpose of appreciation and enjoyment by the public, some areas which are in a natural state, largely unaltered by human works, free from infrastructure or facilities, except for approved navigational markers and vessel moorings which are essential for the protection, wise use and appreciation of the Marine Park.

10.2 Use and Entry

Subject to Part Three (Designated Area Provisions), Part Four (Additional Uses and Exemptions) and any conditions imposed by an approved Reef Use Plan, and irrespective of the four public access zones (General Use, General Use (No Trawling), Marine Park Recreation and Marine National Park) over which this subzoning may be applied:

- (a) no fixed structures or permanently moored facilities will be allowed (except for approved moorings and markers) to ensure the visual amenity of the area is not adversely affected; and
- (b) tourist activities in this subzone will be limited by permit.

PART THREE - DESIGNATED AREA PROVISIONS

10 REPLENISHMENT AREAS

10.1 Objective

To provide for the replenishment of living natural resources in heavily used areas of the Great Barrier Reef Marine Park, by restricting, for a specified period of time, activities which remove those living natural resources.

10.2 Use and Entry

Any of the following special management provisions may be applied in a Replenishment Area:

- (a) fishing is not permitted, other than trolling for pelagic species which may be carried out during the period from the first day of May in a year to the thirty-first day of January in the following year;
- (b) collecting is not permitted;
- (c) traditional fishing and traditional hunting and gathering are not permitted.

10.3 Designation

The Authority may designate an area to be a Replenishment Area by written advertisement stating:

- (a) the boundaries of the Replenishment Area;
- (b) the special management provisions to be applied; and
- (c) the period during which each of those special management provisions shall apply.

Groups of nominated areas, or reefs, within which Replenishment Areas may be designated are described in the Schedule and are indicated on the Zoning Map.

11 SEASONAL CLOSURE AREAS

11.1 Objective

To protect from human intrusion, for a specified period of time, areas of importance to the breeding of some animals in the Marine Park.

11.2 Use and Entry

Subject to Part Four (Additional Uses and Exemptions) this clause sets out the only purposes for which a Seasonal Closure Area may be used or entered during such time as is specified by written advertisement that the closure applies:

- (a) the operation of aircraft at an altitude of not less than 500 feet above ground or water;

- (b) in a case where a person is permitted by or under a law of Queensland to use or enter upon an island that lies within a Seasonal Closure Area - the navigation and operation of a vessel in the Seasonal Closure Area by that person for that use or entry and if any equipment normally used for fishing or collecting is stowed or secured;
- (c) with the written permission of the Authority or its delegate:
 - (i) scientific research that cannot be carried out at any other location;
 - (ii) any other purpose not listed in this clause consistent with the objective of the designated area.

11.3 Designation

Nominated areas which may be designated as Seasonal Closure Areas are described in the Schedule and are indicated on the Zoning Map.

The Authority may designate any or all of the nominated areas to be Seasonal Closure Areas by written advertisement stating:

- (a) the boundaries of the Seasonal Closure Area; and
- (b) the period during which the closure is to apply in accordance with the following:

12 DEFENCE AREAS

12.1 Objective

To make provision, in the interests of public safety, for control of the use of, and entry into, areas of the Great Barrier Reef Marine Park used for the conduct of defence operations.

12.2 Use and Entry

Subject to notification to the Authority or its delegate, use of and entry into the area may be controlled in accordance with the Defence Force regulations applying to that area.

12.3 Designation

The boundaries of the Defence Areas described in the Schedule are indicated on the Zoning Map. By written advertisement, the Authority may designate any other areas to be Defence Areas.

13 SHIPPING AREAS

13.1 Objective

To make provision for the navigation and operation of ships.

13.2 Use and Entry

The navigation and operation of ships is permitted in a Shipping Area, provided that any equipment that is normally used for fishing or collecting is stowed or secured at all times at which the vessel is in a zone in which the use of that equipment is not permitted under this Zoning Plan.

13.3 Designation

The locations of Shipping Areas are not indicated in this Zoning Plan or on the Zoning Map. By written advertisement, the Authority may designate any area to be a Shipping Area.

CAUTION. Because Shipping Areas can be located outside recognised shipping lanes these areas could contain reefs and other hazards to navigation.

14 SPECIAL MANAGEMENT AREAS

14.1 Objective

To provide for areas of the Great Barrier Reef Marine Park to be specially managed for the purposes of conservation of natural resources, undisturbed scientific research, appreciation by the public or public safety, as appropriate.

14.2 Use and Entry

Use of and entry into the area may be controlled in accordance with the special management provisions which may be designated by the Authority from time to time.

14.3 Designation

The Authority may, by written advertisement and in accordance with the Regulations, designate an area to be a Special Management Area and designate the special management provisions to be applied in that area during such period as is specified.

The Special Management Area or Areas for the time being designated in relation to a reef or an island may not incorporate more than 20 percent of the area of that reef or island, nor more than 20 percent of the area enclosed within the 500 metre line

around that reef or 20 percent of the area enclosed within the coastal 500 metre line around that island.

In the case of a fringing reef, the Special Management Area or Areas for the time being designated may not incorporate more than 20 percent of the area enclosed within the coastal 500 metre line around the island, islands or mainland to which that reef is attached and not more than 1 kilometre in any 5 kilometres of the coastline at low water of the island, islands or mainland to which that reef is attached.

The locations of Special Management Areas are not indicated in this Zoning Plan or on the Zoning Map.

PART FOUR - ADDITIONAL USES AND EXEMPTIONS

15 ACCESS IN SPECIAL CIRCUMSTANCES

In addition to the purposes specified in Part Two and Part Three of this Zoning Plan, a zone or designated area may be used or entered for the purpose of:

- (a) saving human life or avoiding the risk of injury to a human being;
- (b) locating or securing the safety of an aircraft, vessel or structure which is, or may be, endangered by stress of weather or by navigational or operational hazards;
- (c) government reconnaissance, surveillance, or law enforcement (including enforcement of the Act and Regulations);
- (d) monitoring of the Marine Park by, or with the approval of, the Authority;
- (e) dealing with an emergency involving a serious threat to the environment;
- (f) after notification to the Authority or its delegate and subject to any directions the Authority or its delegate may impose as are reasonably necessary for the conservation, protection and preservation of the Marine Park and property and things in the Marine Park:
 - (i) the removal of a vessel that is wrecked, stranded, sunk or abandoned (but does not apply to a wreck protected under the Historic Shipwrecks Act 1976);
 - (ii) the conduct and servicing of authorised navigational aids and their ancillary buildings and works, including the operation of vessels and aircraft for these purposes;
 - (iii) defence operations, including the use of ships and aircraft;
 - (iv) government geodetic surveys, government bathymetric surveys or similar government surveys;

16 RESEARCH

The Authority may grant permission for the conduct of research within a zone under this Zoning Plan notwithstanding any express or implied limitation on the use of, or entry into, that zone for other purposes.

SCHEDULE

Notes to the Schedule

The areas in this Schedule prefixed by a number or a bracketed letter together constitute a zone, a subzone or a designated area, and have the name of the zone, subzone or designated area set out in bold uppercase type.

A reference to a reef, for example, unnamed reef (reef 15-034), is a reference to a reef depicted and numbered on the Great Barrier Reef Series 1:250 000 mapsheets.

All co-ordinates given in this Schedule are expressed in terms of Australian Geodetic Datum 1966 (AGD 66).

Where a part of a boundary of a zone, or designated area, is described by reference to a line every point of which is a particular distance seaward from the nearest point of the reef or coastline to which it applies, and that boundary intersects another reef, coastline, zone boundary, or designated area boundary, then in the area of overlap the boundary shall be the median line.

A. GENERAL USE ZONE

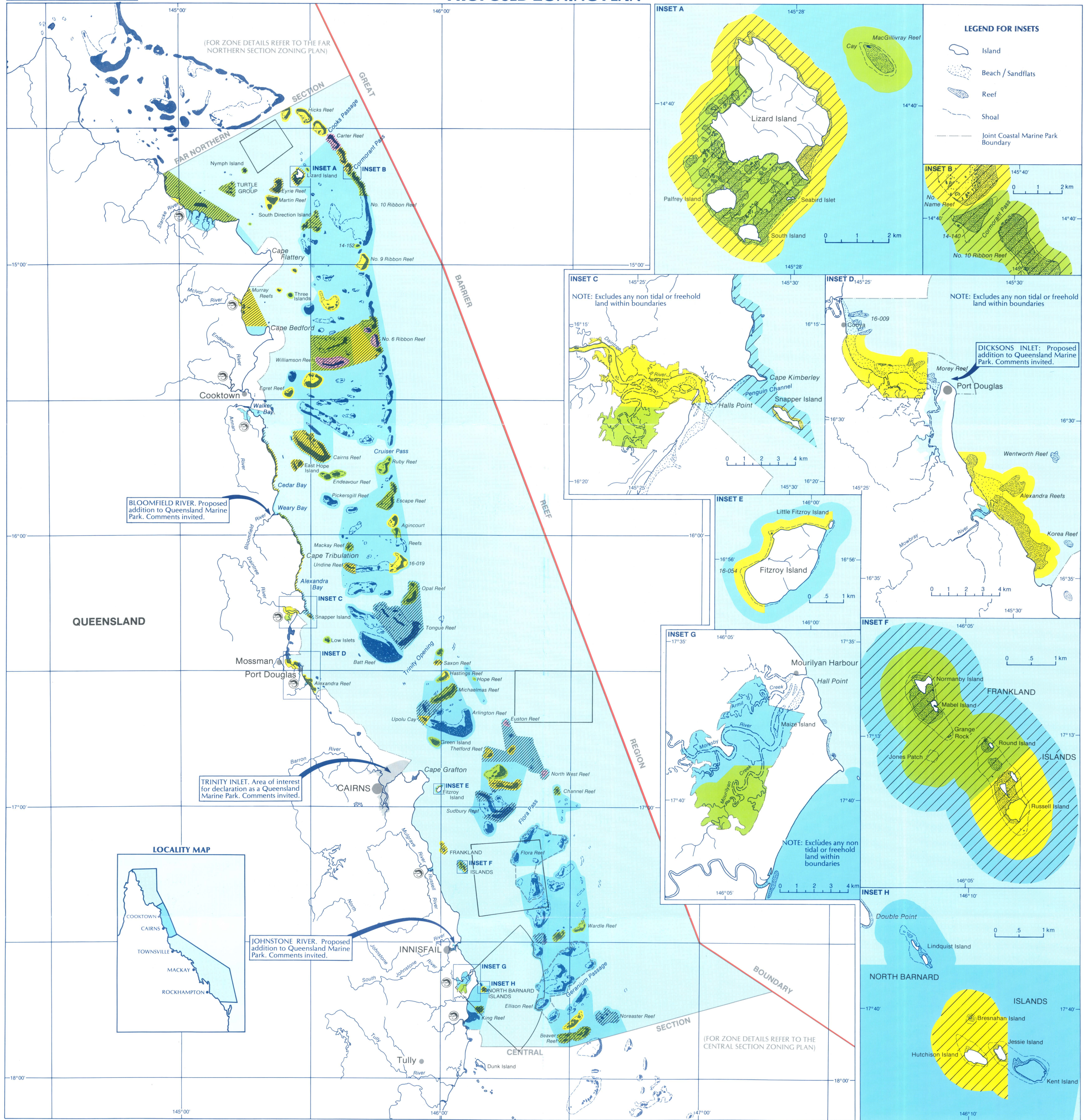

ZONING INFORMATION
General Use Zone (light blue) — The least restrictive of the zones. Provides for all reasonable uses including shipping and trawling. Prohibited activities are mining, oil drilling, commercial spearfishing and spearfishing with underwater breathing apparatus.
General Use (No Trawling) Zone (dark blue) — Provides for reasonable use including most commercial and recreational activities. Trawling and general shipping are prohibited as well as those activities not allowed in the General Use Zone.
Marine Park Recreation Zone (yellow) — Provides for appreciation and recreational use, without the effects of some types of fishing, such as spearfishing, and collecting. Limited line fishing is allowed. Other prohibited activities are those not allowed in General Use (No Trawling) Zone.
Marine National Park Zone (green) — Provides for appreciation and enjoyment of marine areas in their relatively undisturbed state. It is a 'look but don't take' zone. Fishing and activities which remove natural resources are prohibited, as well as those not allowed in the Marine Park Recreation Zone.
Preservation Zone (pink) — Set aside for the preservation of the area in an undisturbed state. All entry is prohibited (except in an emergency) with the exception of permitted scientific research which cannot be conducted elsewhere.
The existing Zoning Plan also has provision to apply periodic restrictions to further areas. Such areas include **Replenishment Areas**, **Special Management Areas** and **Defence Areas** (see the Zoning Plan for details).
A Tourism strategy is proposed by the application of a 'No Structures' Subzone shown as hatched areas on the zoning map: —
No Structures Subzone — Set aside, for the purpose of appreciation and enjoyment by the public, some areas free from infrastructure or facilities, except for approved navigational markers and vessel moorings. The proposed zoning plan gives details of the zones and the subzone, and their locations. The booklet "Zoning the Cairns Section" outlines the reasons behind the proposed zoning and summarises the public comments from the first phase of public participation.
