

DON'T BE THE CATCH OF THE DAY!

Yellow Zones (Limited Fishing)

You can line fish in Yellow Zones with ONE hand-held rod OR handline per person with ONE hook attached to that line.

You can troll behind a vessel while it is underway with no more than THREE lines per person with up to SIX hooks in total per person.

Green Zones (No Fishing allowed)

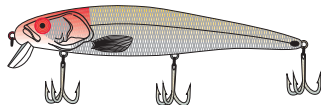
One hook can be:



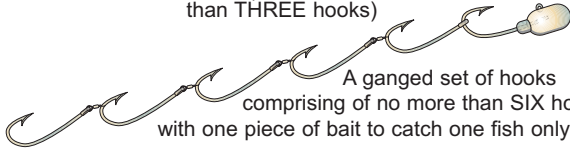
A single hook



A single-shanked double or treble hook

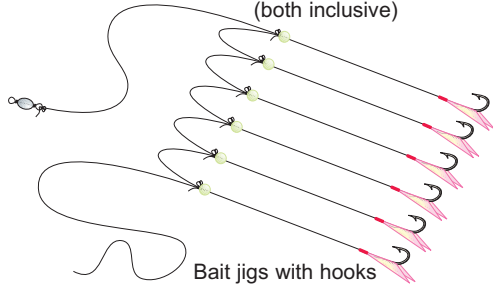


A lure (an artificial bait with no more than THREE hooks)

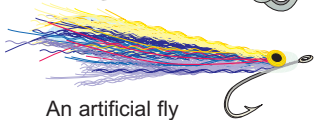


A ganged set of hooks comprising of no more than SIX hooks with one piece of bait to catch one fish only

A bait jig comprising no more than SIX hooks sized between Number 1 and Number 12 (both inclusive)



Bait jigs with hooks sized 1/0 and larger can NOT be used.
